

Brief History of the Antimatter Electrical Generator

Early times

My father, Cristóbal Molina Lemus, MD, (1919-1999) had inspired my brother and me since our early youth to develop an accumulator that could power a vehicle. He was a great admirer of Thomas Alba Edison and use to tell us many of his stories. He knew Edison wanted to develop an accumulator powerful enough to run a vehicle, but that the effort had been abandoned. We learned that the cause was that his batteries didn't have enough power for the task, which still today is the main difficulty.

Once in a while along our lives we use to go back to the subject, but it wasn't until probably 1991 that we had a clue on the direction we could go in the search of such device. I had already worked for some time in other types of energy like the solar and the eolic energies.

In 1992 I started working on a novel conception of an Electrical Micro-Accumulator. I had some interesting principles to work with and in the following year I built some test prototypes. The idea of powering a vehicle with electric accumulators was to avoid the pollution that oil consumption was producing. But, soon enough, I realized that even if I could achieve a successful model, it would be a born-dead technology because whatever energy I could store into it would have to be produced by unclean means, mainly.

Even tough the principles I had were very interesting and still today could lead to a powerful micro-accumulator, I decided to abandon the project and to devote my life to the search of a clean and inexhaustible source of energy, an idea that had been in my mind already for probably more than a decade.

In May of 1993 I started working on what I identified as a possible new and inexhaustible source of energy. I rapidly developed all the theories and concepts involved and made drawings of my new designs, all of what I would use years later in my patent applications. For three consecutive years, working with my own resources in my native Colombia, I built prototypes and fixtures to confirm the principles. I firmly believed that what I had found would lead me to the inexhaustible source of energy I was looking for. I called this device the "Continuous Electrical Generator".

Moving to the US

In February of 1996 I moved with my family to the United States in the search for funding and conditions for the development of this and other inventions. By August of the same year I

founded in Florida “Molina Generation Machines, Inc.” along with a couple of family friends as funding partners and my father as the catalyzer, for the development of the new technology.

I built a laboratory and for several years I constructed and tested many prototypes in order to validate my theories. At some point it seemed that I had succeeded in my goals, because some of the prototypes were apparently yielding energy far over the unity.

I had filed for patents on my findings sometime before while I was building and perfecting the prototypes on the technologies I thought then, were already complete. My enthusiasm with this apparent success led me to program a formal launching to present my findings to the world. This took place by year 2001.

Nevertheless, further tests and deeper analysis showed clearly that there was something missing to make these inventions to work properly, and that the excess of power was only apparent power, not real power. I decided to cancel the launching until the technology could be fully proven.

We had sent invitations to the launching to very important people and prominent politicians in Washington and the United States. This aborted launching may have been the cause of a rumor that circulated strongly in Washington at the time, of an “earth-shattering technology” that was going to break through at any time. The media called it “Ginger” and because they couldn’t find the source of the rumor they attributed it to an inventor of New Hampshire, who was quietly working on.....something else.

After Sep. 11th, 2001, it became very difficult to get new funding, and the company’s resources became more and more scarce. The last funding the company received from its partners, fourteen or fifteen at the time, had come in by mid 2001 and the aborted launching had depleted its resources to no more than four or six months of operation.

Entering 2002 I had to turn to personal indebtedness and credit cards to keep the company alive and to be able to continue working. I continued my efforts to complete the inventions without rest for almost two years despite the lack of funds and support from my associates, at a very high price for me and my family.

However, despite all my efforts, I couldn’t solve then whatever was missing with the invention to make it work as intended. At the end of year 2003, totally broken, I had no choice but to surrender the company, including the patent applications, the whole laboratory and all the prototypes and devices I had built for the past ten years to some of my ex-associates just to avoid conflicts and to be able to move on with my life.

I ignore what they have done with all that, but I know that some of them were posed to complete the invention without me, the inventor, for their own benefit. I even suspect that at least one of them intentionally provoked the collapse of the company to take the project for himself. I have not heard that those ex-associates have achieved any success whatsoever.

No complains or regrets on my part, just plain history.

Back to Colombia

Not having any doors open in the United States we decided to return to Colombia, where we spent almost a year in unstable conditions.

But, even under the hardest circumstances, I have never stopped working and studying in my efforts to achieve my goals. My faith and perseverance produced fruit at the end of year 2004. Finally, I had a clear vision of what my inventions were missing, except that what was missing was a lot more important than what I had until then.

I had been in the search of this knowledge for so many years and under all kinds of circumstances, not to recognize it when it came, by the pure grace of God.

In November of 2004, while still living in Colombia, I filed a Provisional Patent Application in the United States for my discoveries and my new designs and inventions, which included a totally new view on many aspects of Physics. I named the new invention the “Antimatter Electrical Generator”.

Returning to the US

In June of 2005 we returned to the United States in the search of a new opportunity and a new start, but with something very important in our hands.

During year 2005, I filed Patent Applications for the United States and Worldwide, on which I hold a Patent Pending status at the moment.

These new discoveries and inventions are based on pure Physics and solid science and have nothing to do with over-unity devices or things like that.

I decided to appeal to common people of the world willing to save the planet for our children, environmental organizations, philanthropists, etc. to fund this project because whenever I get an interested “Sophisticated Investor”, invariably, they want to take over the project for just a handful of dollars.

This is a project from the people, for the people. As far as I can maintain a fair control of the project, given that it works as intended, I can guarantee that the entire world will benefit from it, including the poor of the world.

Will it be like that if the big corporations take it over?

I launched in August of 2006 my internet page “Give the Planet a Chance”, <http://www.givetheplanetachance.com/>, with the hope to raise funds to develop these inventions and to make them known to the world.

If for any reason I could not develop the project myself, this will be the legacy of an honest man for mankind and for the children of the world.
